

Clément Camp graduated in 2010 from the École Normale Supérieure de Lyon and received his PhD in 2014 from the University of Grenoble for his work on low-valent *f*-element compounds, performed under the supervision of Dr. Marinella Mazzanti. He then joined Prof. John Arnold's group at the University of California - Berkeley for postdoctoral training before starting his independent career in 2016 at the CP2M Laboratory (Lyon) as CNRS researcher. His research focuses on surface organometallic chemistry and cooperative effects in catalysis. Clément was awarded an ERC StG in 2021 and received the CNRS bronze medal in 2022.
