



Christopher Teskey studied Natural Sciences (University of Cambridge) before obtaining his PhD in 2016 with Michael Greaney (University of Manchester). After one year as an EPSRC Doctoral Prize Fellowship, he moved to the University of Vienna as a Lise Meitner Postdoctoral Fellow with Nuno Maulide.

From March 2019, Chris has been an Independent Group Leader in the Institute of Organic Chemistry at RWTH Aachen University funded by a Liebig Fellowship. His research interests centre around photochemical transition metal catalysis and his achievements in this area have been recognised by the ADUC prize in 2022. More recently, he is the first winner of the Karl Ziegler Young Scientist Award in 2023.

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
